- 8:30 am** Meet at the town docks in Haliburton. Introductions and overview of itinerary. Travel to Snowden Park for hike.
- 9:15-10:30** Walk about on trails identifying and sampling (where appropriate) teas and other wild delights of Haliburton County.
- 10:45-12:30** Return to Wintergreen for an out of the ordinary country kitchen experience of preparing a Haliburton Tortiere, a French-Canadian tradition with a Haliburton twist using local ingredients. Lunch is a delicious family-style meal in a reconstructed 1892 timber-framed barn.
- 1-2:30** Gather up at a Waverley Brook Farm five generation family farm working with the four seasons and leave with a "Gift from the Land" organic sampler.
- 3:00-4:30** A fascinating behind-the-scenes look at small scale maple syrup winemaker. A visit to Maple Moon Estate Winery includes taste teasing samples and time to browse the interesting wine and collectables shop.
- 5:00-6:30** Time to relax and get refreshed for evening dinner
- 6:30-8:00** A casual dining experience with the group at one of Haliburton's finest restaurants will top off a great day of food, fun and activity.
